




- Three-year National Plan to improve Digital Participation

- Guaranteed funding over three years for targeted marketing and outreach


Digital Infrastructure


- Universal access to today's broadband services by 2012 will allow everyone in the UK to participate for the first time
- Next Generation fund for investment in tomorrow's broadband, to extend superfast services throughout the UK
- Digital Radio upgrade by the end of 2015
- Mobile spectrum liberalisation, enhancing 3G coverage and accelerating Next Generation mobile services
- New role for sectoral regulator (Ofcom) to carry out full assessment of the UK's communications infrastructure

Digital Content

- Robust legal and regulatory framework for combating Digital Piracy
- Digital Test Beds to promote innovation/experimentation around digital content
- TV Licence Fee: contained contestability, primarily to secure news in the nations, regionally and locally
- A new direction for Channel 4
- Guidance and clarification on the media merger regime
- Support for public service content partnerships
