- LEPs can be part of the solution but need guidance & support






Launch of LEP Growth Service - July 2015



# **Dowling Review Highlights & Comments**

- Current innovation system is too complex
  - especially for smaller businesses
  - many businesses don't even get out of the starting blocks
- · Effective brokerage is essential
- Motivation for Universities & Academics needs changing
- Pump prime funding is very important
- Government innovation strategy is critical and does make a difference





### **Key Points for my Business**

- · Simplify the innovation collaboration system
  - or as least "hide the wiring" (& the administration)
- Improve motivation
  - for both business & universities
- Effective brokerage is essential for both sides
  - as a business, we are already motived to collaborate
  - but the whole process is still far to complicated & too slow



#### **Summary**

- The Dowling Review is outstanding and captures the current landscape extremely effectively
- Well constructed recommendations take account of, & build on, existing innovation & collaboration infrastructure
- Government action based on these recommendations can have a meaningful and positive impact on our nation's long term economic growth
- LEPs are relatively new organisations which, given appropriate support and guidance could be used very effectively to deliver significantly improved business-university collaboration to address local priorities
  - particularly for smaller businesses
- There is a massive gap in the support infrastructure for businesses that:
  - are above "medium" size (up to 249 employees)
  - are clearly not very large
  - have massive growth potential given appropriate support
